Addressing the gap

- Give new projects option of autonomous funding governance to match autonomous project governance
- Directed Fund approach:
 - Pool financial resources from interested parties
 - Gives orgs input into how their money is spent
- Foundation members would have option to support each Directed Fund, and Directed Funds supporters would be required to join as Foundation Members
